

SCHOOL HISTORY



The first high school, called Morrison Academy, began in 1906 with Professor Evans as principal and six students in the graduating class. In 1921, a new grammar school was erected, and in 1942, a new high school was constructed. The combination grammar and high school enrolled approximately 450 Kindergarten through 12th grade pupils.

In 1969, due to the consolidation of all county high schools, Morrison School became a K through 8th grade school with O.M. Womack Jr. as principal.

In 2010, land was purchased and in 2011, construction began on a new building that was designed to accommodate our growing student population and overcrowding issues. The new building opened in 2012. We serve approximately 450 students from Pre-K through 8th grade from the Morrison Community.
